

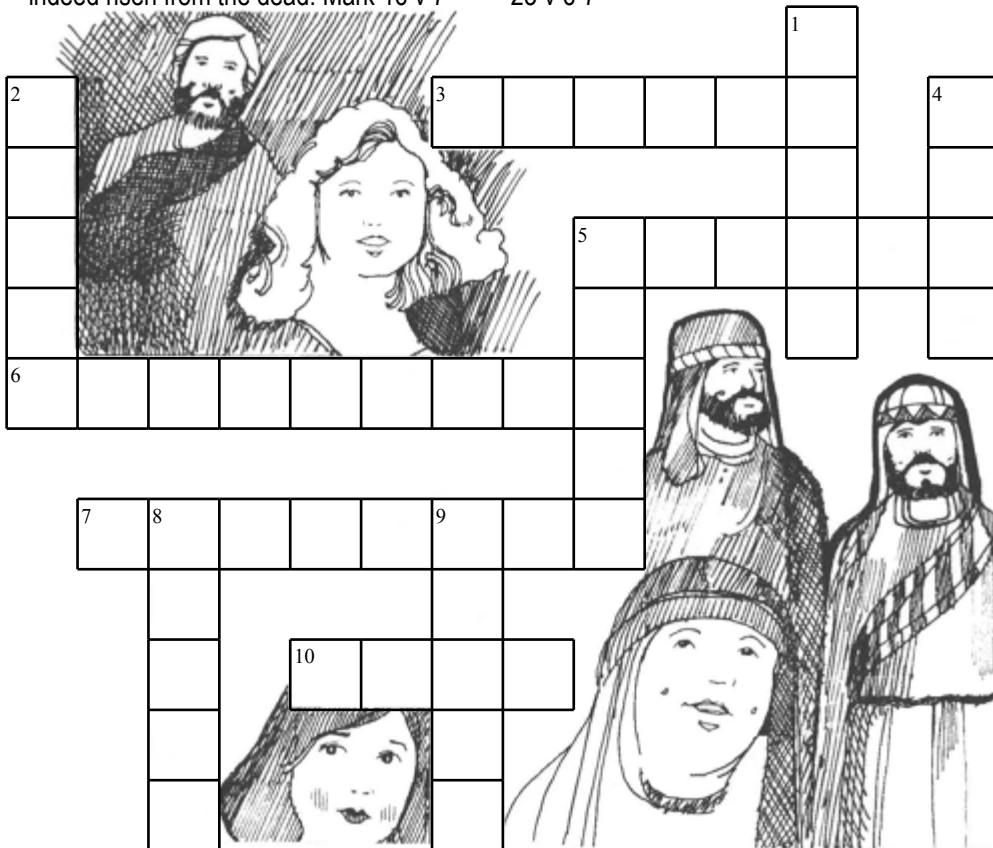
CROSSWORD Children's Corner
